NETEXTENDER SSL VPN GUIDE

Use this procedure to connect to the Agency's internal computer network from the Internet using the SonicWall NetExtender SSL VPN client. Before connecting please note:

- The NetExtender client software must be installed on your computer in order to make a VPN connection.
 - Please contact Help Desk to have the NetExtender client software installed on your agency-assigned laptop, if it isn't already.
 - For approved use on home personal computers, download the NetExtender client software from: http://dl.pscleanair.org/NetExtender. Save the .msi installation file to your computer, double-click and follow the prompts to install.
- After making a VPN connection, agency-assigned laptops automatically use your login credentials to connect with network resources such as Outlook email and the Chinook file server.
- Users connecting from home personal computers must supply their agency login and password for each resource to which they attempt to connect, or preferably make a Remote Desktop Connection to their agency computer and work from there. Running the Cleanair app is only supported over Remote Desktop.
- 1. Click the SonicWall NetExtender icon in your Start Menu, or double-click the icon in the System Tray near the Windows taskbar clock.



- 2. In the SonicWALL NetExtender client window, type the following logon information:
 - a. Server: sonic.pscleanair.org:4433.
 - b. Username: Your agency logon name.
 - c. Password: Your agency logon password.
 - d. Domain: pscleanair.org.

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- 3. Click **Connect**. After a few seconds you are connected to the agency's internal network and able to access its resources. The taskbar icon turns blue and it is safe to close the NetExtender window.
 - a. Note: You may receive a Security Alert warning message concerning the security certificate. Click Always Trust to add the SonicWall certificate to your computer's certificate store.
- 4. To disconnect from VPN, right-click the taskbar icon and select **Disconnect** from the pop-up menu. **Please remember to disconnect when you are no longer using VPN.**
